Sealed bids must be received by the Lee County Engineer at the office of the Lee County Highway Department, 1111 Auburn Street, Opelika, Alabama 36803 by 10 AM CDT, August 13, 2010. At that time they will be publicly opened for constructing the following:

BRIDGE REPLACEMENT (PRECAST) ON LEE ROAD-154 AT A TRIBUTARY OF HALAWAKEE CREEK
EAST OF OPELIKA

The Length Of This Project Is: 0.047 Miles.

The Entire Project Shall Be Completed In Ninety (90) Working Days.

A bidding proposal may be purchased for \$5 and plans may be purchased for \$6 per set. Plans and proposals are available at the Lee County Highway Department, 1111 Auburn Street, Opelika, AL 36803. Checks should be made payable to the Lee County Commission. Plans and proposals will be mailed only upon receipt of remittance. No refunds will be made.

A cashier's check or bid bond for 5% of bid (maximum - \$10,000) made payable to the Lee County Commission must accompany each bid as evidence of good faith.

The bracket range is shown only to provide general financial information to contractors and bonding companies concerning the project's complexity and size. This bracket should not be used in preparing a bid, nor will this bracket have any bearing on the decision to award this contract.

The bracket estimate on this project is from \$315,000 to \$385,000
